It will help contain the spread and get us through this.
- Citizens are selflessly responding to the needs of others, checking up on vulnerable family members and neighbors.
- Businesses and retail workers are working hard to make goods and services available to us. Please treat them with the utmost respect their jobs are especially difficult right now.

- The Town has issued an emergency order that will help facilitate the use of Town resources in responding to this crisis.
- Our Police Department and Public Works Department are on the job, keeping our community safe and maintaining the Town's infrastructure.
- While Town Hall is presently closed to the public, staff continues to work to serve the resident's needs, practicing social distancing guidance including having staff members work from home as can be accommodated.

In addition to grocery shopping, or medical care, there are other essential services that are available to us during the time of Stay at Home and other social distancing orders. Among them are:

- The great outdoors! We live in an enviable place full of natural beauty. What a great opportunity for residents to get out to take a walk, do some exercise, or simply get outdoors and enjoy our beautiful vistas.
